MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Combat Maneuver Training Center (CMTC) 2003 Exercise Rules of Engagement (EXROE)

1. Purpose.

a. The Exercise Rules of Engagement (EXROE) establish the basic guidelines for the conduct of Rotational Unit CMTC Force on Force Training and Peace Stability Operations Training. Clarification of these guidelines and explanations of procedures are available from certified, permanent party O/Cs.

b. All personnel participating in training at CMTC must know the EXROE. Violations of the EXROE may result in offending personnel/vehicle(s) becoming a 'Cheat Kill' and reporting of the soldier to the unit's chain of command.

c. This EXROE supersedes all previous CMTC Rules Of Engagements (ROEs), Supplemental ROEs and ROE Implementation Documents.

d. Contact the CMTC Operations Group (OPSGP) S3 (466-4458/59) for additional information concerning the EXROE.

2. Applicability. The EXROE applies to all personnel participating in, supporting, observing, or controlling rotational unit training at CMTC. The Commander, Operations Group, is the approval authority for exceptions to the EXROE. In addition, all personnel and units at CMTC must abide by all applicable regulations and tactical orders.
